You are cordially invited to be a vendor at our 10th Annual Herb and Lavender Fair at El Rancho de las Golondrinas, July 28th and 29th, 2012. If you have lavender plants or products, culinary or medicinal herbs, dye plants or natural dye extracts, or herbal products, we welcome you to participate in this popular event. We are also extending this invitation to a handful of other Arts & Crafts vendors. There will be wonderful music, herb garden tours, hands-on activities and culinary demonstrations. All museum exhibits will be open. The admission for the public is \$8 for adults, \$5 for seniors (62) and teens, (13-20). Under 13 is FREE.

Vendors who offer educational presentations or hands-on activities will receive a discount. Vendor setup time is 7 AM to 10 AM on Saturday and 8 AM to 10 PM on Sunday. Vendors may cover and leave their items at their booths overnight. There is presence on the ranch at night; however, no security will be provided. We are an active ranch and wildlife thrives in La Cienega; we recommend tupperware to store your items.

There are limited 9' x 9' covered spaces available, on a first-come, first-serve basis. These spaces have electricity and a wall behind them with a 4' x 7' peg board for displaying products, for which you must supply your own ¼" hooks. Once these covered spaces are filled, vendors will need to provide their own 10 x 10 tent. All exhibitors will need to bring their own tables, chairs, fans or coolers, extension / drop chords and covers to leave items overnight.

*\$50 - Booth fee for two days*

*\$25 - Discounted fee for vendors with an educational demonstration or hands-on activity.*

*Demonstrations that qualify for a discounted fee include—but are not limited to—showing how a lavender still works, doing a slide presentation on herb growing in the Education Center, making lavender wands with children, etc.*

*Discounted fees are not available for arts and crafts and other vendors. Please indicate on your application or contact me as soon as possible if you will need to use the Education Center, so that it can be scheduled.*
