The Ranch of the Swallows has extended a warm welcome to visitors and travelers since the 1700s when it was the last *paraje* (stopping place) on the El Camino Real.

Today El Rancho de las Golondrinas offers its guests a unique combination of modern facilities and historic buildings. Corporate parties, wedding guests, family reunions, and tour groups can stroll through the rancho, experience what life was like in New Mexico centuries ago and still have the use of modern conveniences.

The Plaza Salazar, a flagstone patio surrounded by a lush garden and covered portal, is a romantic site for weddings or receptions. Couples can also choose to be married in our historic chapel with its spectacular *reredos* (altar screen) or our most popular site with couples, the Wedding Field.

The more rustic Plazas Artesanos and historic Golondrinas Placita and Baca House Placita are perfect locations for cocktail parties, art shows, wine



Our state of the art catering kitchen and covered dining pavilion with side curtains is the perfect venue for rehearsal dinners, wedding receptions, corporate parties, reunions, or any special event.

The air conditioned kiva-shaped Education Center (with a viga and latilla ceiling) can accommodate up to 100. It is suitable for meetings, seminars, or indoor weddings. The adjoining portal provides a welcome place to gather before or after any event.



Docents, weavers, and demonstrators in period dress can be available to demonstrate activities, bake fresh bread in the horno, welcome guests and share their knowledge of the ranch's history for your event.
