at El Rancho de las Golondrinas!



The Ranch of the Swallows has extended a warm welcome to visitors and travelers since 1710 when it was the last *paraje* (stopping place) on the El Camino Real. Today El Rancho de las Golondrinas is a living history museum located on 200 acres 15 miles south of Santa Fe.

Rehearsal dinners and wedding parties will be delighted with the museum's unique combination of historic buildings and modern facilities. Couples can choose from several indoor or outdoor venues for their ceremony and reception. For indoor ceremonies, the historic *capilla* (Chapel) with its spectacular *reredos* (altar screen), created by eleven famous New Mexico *santeros*, accommodates 60; the kiva-shaped Education Center with a *viga* and *latilla* ceiling is a modern alternative for up to 100 guests. The Plaza Salazar, a flagstone patio surrounded by a portal and romantic garden, is perfect for larger groups. Our most popular outdoor location, the Wedding Field, can accommodate over 350 guests.

Receptions can be held in our covered Dining Pavilion or in one of several more rustic plazas. Photos of these sites as well of the rancho can be viewed at our web site: [www.golondrinas.org](http://www.golondrinas.org).
